JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

The father of deceased-Komalpreet Kaur has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking further investigation into the case relating to the unnatural death of his married daughter, namely, Komalpreet Kaur, in light of the present investigating agency having exonerated during investigation the father-in-law and mother-in-law of deceased.

It is submitted that the father-in-law of the deceased, namely, Jagjivan Singh was a police official in State of Punjab and, therefore, the police authority at Gurgaon have deliberately not conducted fair investigation qua the allegations against the person belonging to the police force and his wife, namely, Sukhwinder Kaur.

At the time of hearing, it is admitted that after the commencement of the trial, an application had been moved by the prosecution under Section 319 Cr.P.C. for summoning the father-in-law and mother-in-law of the deceased as additional accused to face trial and the said application was declined by the trial Court. Thereafter, in a revision petition filed by before the Court, notice of motion to the respondents has already been issued.

Faced with the situation that proper remedy has already been initiated and is subjudice, it is agreed that no further orders are required to be passed in the present case.

Dismissed as infructuous.
