Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 439 CrPC is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 03 dated 18.1.2015 under Sections 307, 323, 324, 201 IPC registered at Police Station Bhadaur, District Barnala.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that the parties have entered into a compromise dated 9.3.2015 (Annexure P4) and this factum of compromise has been brought to the notice of the police also. However, the petitioner is in custody since 28.1.2015.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gurdeep Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid fact that the parties have entered into a compromise.

Even learned counsel for the complainant does not dispute the factum of compromise.

Considering the fact that the parties have entered into a compromise, no useful purpose will be served to detain the petitioner in custody for longer period. Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is admitted to regular bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
