Prayer in this petition, filed under Section 482, Cr.P.C., is for quashing of order dated 04.11.2014 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Chandigarh, whereby revision petition filed by the respondent/complainant Daljit

Singh was accepted without affording any opportunity to the petitioner/accused.

Learned counsel for the parties are *ad idem* that opportunity of hearing was not afforded to the petitioner by the learned revisional Court. Therefore, the matter be remitted to the said Court for decision afresh, as per law.
