Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for directing respondent nos. 2 to 4 not to indulge in unnecessary, undue humiliation and harassment of the petitioner at the behest of respondent nos. 5 to 7.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already moved a representation (Annexure P/5) to respondent nos. 2 and 3 – Senior Superintendent of Police, Nawanshahr and S.H.O., Police Station City, Nawanshahr, respectively, but it does not bear any date. Learned counsel further submits that he will submit another representation to the concerned authorities within a week from today. On doing so, the competent authority shall look into the grievance of the petitioner and take action in accordance with law.

Instant petition is disposed of accordingly.
