Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 39 dated 14.02.2015, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Tripuri Town, Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, after arguing for some time, states that he may be permitted to withdraw the instant petition. Learned counsel further states that the petitioner shall surrender/appear before the Court and shall seek regular bail and his bail application may be directed to decide expeditiously.

Present petition is dismissed as withdrawn. However, the petitioner may surrender/appear before the Court. On doing so, his regular bail application be decided expeditiously in accordance with law after police remand, if so sought by the investigation agency.
