Petitioner seeks concession of pre-arrest bail in a case registered at the instance of Ram Bai alleging that the petitioner has entered into a criminal conspiracy after the death of her husband regarding the land by preparing forged relinquishment deed purported to be that of her husband. The land of the husband of the petitioner was allegedly alienated by a forged sale deed.

On asking of the Court, investigating officer ASI Ashok Kumar informs that the complainant herself is in actual physical possession of the property and no registered document has been produced indicating the transfer of the title in the property on the basis of alleged relinquishment deed.

Pursuant to the interim order, the petitioner has joined investigation. Even otherwise, the role attributed to the petitioner is that he acted as an attesting witness to a forged document.

Petition is allowed. Interim order dated 11.05.2015 is hereby
made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2)
Cr.P.C.
