Petitioner, by way of instant petition, seeks quashing of complaint as well as summoning order, however, without availing his equally efficacious alternative remedy of revision against the impugned summoning order.

Admittedly, petitioner has not availed his equally efficacious alternative remedy of revision against the impugned summoning order.

In view of the above, petitioner is relegated to his equally efficacious alternative remedy of revision against the impugned summoning order, at the first instance with liberty to the petitioner to approach this Court again by way of similar quashing petition, if necessity arises. It is also made clear that if the petitioner would file appropriate revision petition against the impugned summoning order within a period of one month from today, respondents shall not raise the issue of limitation against the petitioner.
