On the last date of hearing, it had been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner and not disputed by learned State counsel that almost all witnesses had been examined and that only three witnesses needed to be cross-examined, thereby virtually bringing the trial to its fag end.

Today, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, as a matter of fact, a co-accused of the petitioner, Srilekha Raj Reddy, has also been charge sheeted by the trial court on 10.7.2015, and further that the charge against the petitioner, i.e. Raj Reddy Kellam, also “needs some alteration”. A copy of the said order of the trial court has also been produced in court today by learned State counsel.

In view of the above, since the trial would virtually be starting afresh and the petitioner is already stated to be in custody for about 9 months, therefore, subject to the conditions to be put by the trial court, he is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of that court.
