Petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.70 dated 21.07.2010, under Sections 323, 324, 34 IPC registered at Police Station Amloh, District Fatehgarh Sahib on the basis of compromise. The said FIR was registered at the instance of respondent No.2 Bikar Singh alleging that the petitioners along with co-accused Lakhvir Singh had attacked the complainant by their motorcycle on account of which he had received injuries on his left ankle and left arm. Petitioner No.1 has been attributed a "Kirch" blow on the upper part of the right eyebrow whereas petitioner No.2 is attributed a fist flow on the face of the complainant.

Name of Lakhvir Singh is duly mentioned in the FIR but no reference has been made qua the said main accused in the petition.

It appears that partial quashing of FIR in said circumstances is not permissible.

Dismissed.
