The compromise (Annexure-P7) dated 03.03.2015 filed by the petitioner is taken on record, subject to all just exceptions.

Application stands disposed of.

**Main Case:**

The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C., for grant of concession of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.192 dated 03.11.2014, under Sections 420, 465, 466, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Navi City, District Jalandhar.

Mr. H.K. Aurora, Advocate has appeared on behalf of the complainant and affirms the factum of compromise between the parties and submits that he has no objection if the petitioner is released on bail

subject to compliance of terms and conditions of the compromise.

Considering the compromise arrived at between the parties the petitioner is released on regular bail on furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate Jalandhar.

In case the petitioner fails to comply with the terms and conditions of the compromise, the complainant will be at liberty to move an application for cancellation of the bail.
