RAJ MOHAN SINGH, J. (Oral)

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that on the occasion of marriage of his cousin sister on 22.03.2015 house was sought to be demolished by private respondents. On being objected injuries were inflicted and demolition was done. Threats were also advanced for implicating the petitioner side in some false case. Thereafter FIR No.116 dated 23.03.2015, under Sections 323, 341, 427, 34 IPC is alleged to have been registered against petitioner side by respondent No.6. Both the parties have different version for attracting culpability in terms of Section 452(2) IPC.

Learned counsel highlights that Aashiya and Hazar Khan received injuries which were duly depicted in terms of medical

evidence.

Notice of motion.

At this Stage, Mr. Pradeep Prakash Chahar, D.A.G., Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of official respondents.

In view of nature of order which this Court proposes to pass there is no necessity of filing reply at this stage.

At this stage, without being swayed away with any of the version, let direction be issued to respondent No.2 to have a fair look at the representations dated 28.03.2015 and 30.03.2015 submitted by the petitioner.

Respondent No.2 can devise his own fact-finding mechanism in respect of finding truthful version contained in the allegation, and if need be protect life and property of the petitioner, if he is not involved in any other activity.

If grievance of the petitioner is found to have some worth then respondents may proceed to act in accordance with law.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
