RAJ MOHAN SINGH, J. (Oral)

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that despite registraion of FIR No.346 dated 24.12.2012, under Sections 406/420 IPC, at Police Station Nakodar, Jalandhar against the private respondents, no positive progress has been made by the Police, rather the Police action is surrounded by vices of favouritism.

Petitioner prays fair investigation and protection qua his life and liberty at the hands of private respondents.

Notice of motion.

At this Stage, Mr. Arshdeep S. Kler, D.A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of official respondents.

In view of nature of order which this Court proposes to pass

there is no necessity of filing reply at this stage.

Respondents No.2 and 3 can be obligated to have fair look of the representation dated 24.02.2015 submitted by petitioner in the context of status of investigation and providing necessary protection qua his life and property.

Accordingly, respondent No.2 is directed to look into the representation submitted by the petitioner and, if need be take recourse to some lawful action and in case representation submitted by petitioner is found to have some worth then protection of life and property of petitioner be considered, if he is not found involved in any other case.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
