The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in a case FIR No.169 dated 03.09.2014 registered under Sections 323, 307, 302, 506 & 34 IPC (Sections 148/149 IPC were added subsequently) at Police Station Sadar Ambala, Distt. Ambala.

According to the FIR, some persons were consuming liquor and a quarrel ensued whereupon some other persons were called of which the petitioners were also a part. It is alleged that a free fight followed where the petitioners along with other persons were said to have given fist and danda blows. One person lost his life.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that no specific injury was attributed to the petitioners and co-accused who was similarly placed, was also granted bail by this Court.

On due consideration and noticing that the petitioners have not been attributed any injury to the deceased and finding allegations to be general in nature and the co-accused has already been granted

bail, the instant petition is accepted. It is directed that the petitioners be released on bail in terms of Section 439 Cr.PC subject to their furnishing of bail bonds to the satisfaction of learned Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Ambala.

Nothing said herein shall be construed to be an expression on the merits of the case.
