Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that learned State counsel on 14.11.2014 has made a statement that all dowry articles have been recovered as per list given by the complainant. He has further submitted that petitioners have been declared innocent.

Learned counsel for the complainant has submitted that however, dowry articles have been recovered but certificates belonging the complainant are still with the petitioners and they are not returning the said certificates.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the certificates are not with the petitioners.

Since, the petitioners have been declared innocent and dowry articles have been recovered, so in these circumstances, the order dated 14.05.2014, passed by this Court is made absolute.
