Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 CrPC is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.42 dated 19.3.2015 under Sections 341, 295, 506, 34 IPC registered at Police Station Sarhali, District Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the complainant submits that the offences, for which the petitioner has been charged, are non-bailable.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that pursuant to order dated 12.5.2015, the petitioners have joined

investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Naresh Kumar, does not dispute the fact that the petitioners have joined investigation and submits that their custodial interrogation is no more required.

In view of the aforesaid, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 12.5.2015 passed by this Court is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) CrPC.
