MAHESH GROVER, J.

The petitioner prays for grant of pre-arrest bail in terms of Section 438 Cr.P.C in case FIR no. 5 dated 4.1.2015 registered under Sections 452, 324, 323, 427, 148, 149 IPC, offence under Section 307 IPC added later on, at Police Station Sadar Ferozepur, District Ferozepur.

It is contended by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner was allegedly present with a baseball bat and no injury has been attributed to him.

Noticing the aforesaid facts this Court had granted interim protection to the petitioner vide its order dated 13.5.2015 subject to the compliance of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petitioner has since joined investigation to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer which fact is not controverted by the learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Gurvinder Pal Singh.

Thus, without commenting upon the merits of the case but noticing the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation to the

satisfaction of the Investigating Officer, instant petition is accepted. Interim directions dated 13.5.2015 are hereby made absolute, however subject to the condition that the petitioner continues to comply with the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
