Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 CrPC is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.112 dated 02.12.2012 under Sections 307/452/336/148/149 IPC and Sections 25/27 Arms Act registered at Police Station Sector Harike, District Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that pursuant to order dated 14.5.2015 of this Court, the petitioners have joined investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI

Balwinder Pal, does not dispute the aforesaid fact that the petitioners have joined investigation and further submits that the custodial interrogation of the petitioners is no more required.

Considering the fact that the petitioners have joined investigation and their custodial interrogation is not required, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 14.5.2015 passed by this Court is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) CrPC.
