This petition is for seeking protection of life and liberty of petitioners, who alleged to have married against the wishes of respondents No.4 and 5, parents of petitioner No.2.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has limited his prayer for taking appropriate action in accordance with law on the representation dated 07.05.2015 (Annexure P-5) made by the petitioners. It has been stated that both the petitioners are major. The date of birth of petitioner No.1-Sahil Dadwal is 11.02.1992 as per copy of Matriculation Examination Certificate (Annexure P-1) and that of petitioner No.2-Priyanka Devi is 14.04.1994 as per copy of Matriculation Examination Certificate (Annexure P-2). They got married on 07.05.2015. Photographs of marriage are Annexure P-4.

In view of the limited prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioners and without expressing any opinion on the validity of

marriage of petitioners, this petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur to look into the representation dated 07.05.2015 (Annexure P-5) and take appropriate action in accordance with law, on receipt of certified copy of this order along with representation (Annexure P-5) in his office.

However, it is made clear that this order will have no effect on the validity of alleged marriage of the petitioners or on any other civil or criminal proceedings instituted against them.
