This is a petition under section 482 Cr.P.C. impugning the order dated 01.03.2014 (Annexure P-3), passed by Additional Sessions Judge, Rewari, whereby summoning qua two accused, namely Ashok Kumar and Asharfi Devi has been set-aside.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has assailed the order. According to him, revisional court accepted the plea without any basis.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and given careful thought to the facts of the case.

It appears that a complaint was lodged alleging that certain accused had assaulted the complainant side. One of them suffered injuries including fracture in hand. On the basis of evidence led before the trial court, accused were summoned to face trial. However, two accused namely, Ashok Kumar and Asharfi Devi challenged the order before the revisional court, stating that they were not involved in the case. No evidence had come forth regarding their involvement in the crime. Revisional court accepted the plea.

I find no infirmity with the order passed by the Additional Sessions Judge, Rewari. There is no ground to interfere in inherent jurisdiction of this court.

Dismissed.
