Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.32 dated 25.04.2015, under Section 420 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Ghuman, Police District Batala.

While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed by this Court on 13.05.2015:-

“Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per the allegations in the complaint the petitioner contacted the complainant in March, 2013 and allured him with the proposal of getting his son recruited in Army on payment of ₹1,25,000/-. As per the complainant the payment of ₹1,25,000/- was made in the month of February, 2015. It is contradictory statement.

Notice of motion for 13.08.2015.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed

to surrender before the police and join the investigation. In the event of his arrest being required he be released on interim bail, till next date, on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer. The petitioner shall comply with the conditions specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel who is assisted by Assistant Sub Inspector Daljit Singh has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for further investigation.

Accordingly, interim bail granted by this Court to the petitioner vide order dated 13.05.2015, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
