Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.103 dated 5.11.2013 under Sections 302, 323, 341, 427, 34 IPC registered at Police Station Dugri, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is in custody since 9.11.2013 and he has not been attributed any injury.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Sulakhan Singh, states that in the case in hand, all the prosecution witnesses have already been examined and the case is now fixed before the trial Court on 11.9.2015 for recording the statement of accused under Section 313 Cr.P.C.

After hearing the learned counsel for the parties and taking into consideration the fact that the evidence of the prosecution is already completed, the trial Court is directed to expedite the trial and to conclude the same preferably within three months from today.

In case the trial Court fails to conclude the trial within the aforesaid period, the petitioner shall have a liberty to approach the Court to seek regular bail.
