This order shall dispose of the instant petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C praying for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.63 dated 28.4.2014 under Sections 452, 324, 323, 506, 148, 149 I.P.C. (section 326 I.P.C added subsequently) registered at Police Station, Adampur, District Jalandhar.

Counsel for the parties have been heard.

Injured in the present case is Jatinder Bangar on whose statement F.I.R was lodged. Other person injured was Narender Kumar. Alleged injury attributed to the present petitioner and which has been opined to be grievous in nature so as to attract offence under section 326 I.P.C is on a non-vital part of the body of Narender Kumar.

Petitioner has been in custody since 9.7.2014.

It has gone uncontroverted that co-accused Gagandeep Singh @ Rinku against whom also were similar allegations of having caused injury upon the person of Jatinder Bangar and which had also been opined to be grievous in nature attracting the offence under Section 326 I.P.C, has been granted the benefit of regular bail vide order dated 1.5.2015 passed in

CRM No. M-4246 of 2015.

Accordingly, present petition is allowed.

Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of C.J.M.,
Jalandhar.
