Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.67 dated 23.04.2015, under Section 420 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station City Rupnagar.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Vide order dated 13.05.2015, this Court directed that in the event of arrest, the petitioner would be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer in connection with above-said case FIR.

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On instructions from the investigating officer, learned State counsel informs that the petitioner has joined the investigation. Learned State counsel further states that nothing is to be recovered from the petitioner and his custodial interrogation is not required.
