The present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (in short, "Cr.P.C.") for grant of concession of regular bail to the petitioner in case bearing First Information Report No.1 dated 03.01.2015 under Sections 22, 61 and 85 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, registered at Police Station Bareta, District Mansa.

The submissions made by learned counsel representing the petitioner and learned counsel representing the State of Punjab have been considered.

The petitioner is in custody since 04.01.2015 and the recovery effected from the petitioner is non commercial. The trial of the case is still

likely to take some time and there appears no plausible ground to detain the petitioner further in custody. He is admitted to bail, subject to his furnishing bail/ surety bonds, to the satisfaction of Area Magistrate/Trial Court, Mansa.
