JASPAL SINGH, J (ORAL)

This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C seeking pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 80 dated April 16, 2015 under Section 304 and 279 IPC, registered at Police Station Chherretta, Amritsar City, District Amritsar.

2. While issuing notice of motion on May 15, 2015 following observation was made by this Court:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner, inter-alia, contends that unfortunately, son of the complainant has lost his life due to sustaining of injury in the vehicular accident but at the most, case of prosecution falls within the ambit of Section 304-A IPC and not under Section 304 IPC. There is also a debatable question if an offence under Section 304 IPC is attracted in the given circumstances.

Notice of motion for 21.07.2015.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest the petitioner shall be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer. He shall join the investigation as and when required by the Investigating Officer. He shall also comply with the other conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure”.

3. Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Gulshan Lal submits that in compliance of order dated May 15, 2015, petitioner has already joined investigation and he is no more required for further custodial interrogation.

4. In view of above, order dated May 15, 2015 is hereby, made absolute.

5. Disposed of.

6. However, petitioner shall abide by all the conditions, as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
