This is the second petition filed by the petitioner for the grant of regular bail, the first one having been dismissed as withdrawn on 1.5.2015, after the same was argued by learned counsel for the petitioner for some time.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody since 2.9.2013. However, the trial of the case has not made any significant progress so far.

After obtaining instructions from SI Vijay Kumar, learned State counsel has informed the Court that out of the eight witnesses cited by the prosecution, three have been examined, two out of whom have been examined partly. Now, the trial is scheduled for 9.2.2015.

Heard. The petition is disposed of with a direction to the trial Court to expedite the trial and conclude the same, preferably within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
