Called twice.

Neither anybody has come present to press this petition nor any request for pass over has been made on behalf of the petitioner.

Petitioner seeks bail pending trial in FIR No.26 dated 27.2.2012 registered under Sections 376, 506, 148 and 149 IPC (challan presented under Sections 376 (G) and 506 IPC and Section 3 of SC & ST Act, 1989) at Police Station Behal, District Bhiwani.

Notice to the Advocate General, Haryana.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Ashish Yadav, Addl. A.G., Haryana, accepts notice.

Learned counsel for the State submits that petitioner remained proclaimed offender for a period of about two years. He further submits that in the meantime, co-accused of the petitioner has been convicted on 27.8.2013. Petitioner came to be arrested on 15.7.2014. Out of total 28 prosecution witnesses, 7 have already been examined and next date before the learned trial Court is 1.7.2015.

In view of the above and without commenting anything further on the merits at this stage, lest it should prejudice the rights of either of the parties, no case for bail pending trial is made out.

Dismissed.
