The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of Rapat No.22 dated 11.06.2010, under Sections 336/148/149 IPC and Sections 25/27/54/59 of the Arms Act recorded in FIR No.32 dated 11.06.2010, under Sections 336/148/149 IPC and Sections 25/27/54/59 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Ajitwal, District Moga on the basis of compromise, which is stated to have been entered into between the parties.
