Challenge in the present appeal is to the judgment and decree of the learned Lower Appellate Court whereby that of the trial Court was reversed and the suit filed by the respondent-plaintiff for permanent injunction restraining the appellants from disconnecting the electric connection, was decreed.

Two electric connections were standing in the name of the respondent-plaintiff. The connections were sought to be disconnected allegedly on the ground of non-payment of two bills raised for a sum of ₹ 2,919/- and ₹ 3,081/-. The trial Court dismissed the suit. However, while accepting the appeal filed by the respondent-plaintiff, the learned Lower Appellate Court decreed the suit and restrained the appellants/defendants from disconnecting the power supply of the plaintiff.

Considering the fact that the amount involved in the present appeal, on account of non-payment of which the electric connections of the respondent were sought to be disconnected, is ₹ 2,919/- and ₹ 3,081/-, this Court would not like to go into the merits of the case. The appeal is accordingly dismissed.
