Petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.15 dated 09.02.2014, under Sections 364, 365, 384, 420, 342 & 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Khizarabad District Yamuna Nagar on the basis of compromise.

The said FIR was registered at the instance of respondent No.2- Surinder Kaur alleging that the petitioners had kidnapped Gurmit Singh- respondent No.3 nephew of the complainant and got registered a sale deed on 15.05.2013.

The civil dispute between the parties has also been compromised so far as the petitioners-accused are concerned. Statements of the complainant and victim stands already recorded by the trial Court. A report has been received regarding the matter having been compromised.

The affidavits of the parties have also been placed on record in context to the compromise.

Following the full Bench judgment of this Court in **Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and others 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052**, the petition is allowed. The aforesaid FIR and all the criminal proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise, subject to the final settlement before the Civil Court as per the terms of the compromise.
