Petitioner seeks bail pending trial in FIR No.105 dated 03.06.2014 under Sections 419/420/467/468/471/120-B/204 IPC, registered at Police Station Dakha, District Ludhiana.

Mr. K.D. Sachdeva, Addl. AG, Punjab accepts notice.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the entire amount, in dispute, has already been repaid. For this purpose, he places reliance on Annexure P-3 (colly). He prays for allowing the present petition.

The abovesaid factual aspect of the matter could not be denied by learned counsel for the State and rightly so, it being a matter of record.

In view of the above and without commenting anything further on the merits, lest it should prejudice the rights of either of the parties, present petition is allowed. Further, since the prosecution evidence is yet to start, conclusion of trial will take some time.

In view of totality of facts and circumstances of the case noticed hereinabove, petitioner is directed to be released on bail pending trial, subject to his furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court.
