Instant petition has been filed under section 482 Cr.P.C seeking quashing of F.I.R No.14 dated 11.11.2013 under sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 218, 201, 120-B I.P.C and sections 7, 13 (1) D read with section 13(2) 88 of Prevention of Corruption Act registered at Police Station, VB Phase-I, Mohali. Further challenge is to the final report submitted by the investigating agency as also the order framing charge dated 27.8.2014.

Learned counsel for the petitioner having argued the matter at some length prays for withdrawal of the instant petition.

Prayer is allowed.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

It is, however, clarified that dismissal of the instant petition as withdrawn shall not preclude the petitioner from raising all pleas that may be available to him in his defence at the appropriate stage and before the appropriate forum.
