FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.68 dated 08.04.2015 under Sections 353,186,323,447 IPC registered at Police Station City-1 Abohar District Fazilka.

The allegations in this anticipatory bail application filed by the petitioners Satpal and Sushil Kumar are that on 8.4.2015 the petitioners had a tiff with complainant Surinder Kumar, Sewadar and in the process had struck a brick hitting on the left eye of the complainant. It is readily accepted by the State counsel that the lone injury attributed to the petitioners is simple in nature and that nothing is to be recovered from the petitioners.

Keeping in view the same and in view of the fact that culpability if any, shall be decided at the time of trial, the

present petition seeking anticipatory bail is allowed. Petitioners be admitted to bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer/Investigating Officer and that they shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
