Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.91 dated 18.07.2013, under Section 21 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substance Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Sarhali, District Tarn Taran.

Affidavit of the petitioner filed by learned counsel for the petitioner is taken on record.

Following order was passed by this Court on 14.05.2015:-

“Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has been regularly appearing during trial of the case bearing FIR No.91 dated 18.07.2013 registered at Police Station Sarhali, District Tarn Taran. The case was adjourned for 19.01.2015 but she noted wrong date, as such, could not appear on date fixed and the trial Court after cancelling her

bail, issued non-bailable warrants against her.

Notice of motion for 17.08.2015.

In the meanwhile, petitioner will surrender before the trial Court within a week and on her surrendering before the Court, she will be allowed interim bail by the trial Court on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to its satisfaction, till the next date.

The petitioner will file affidavit on the next date before this Court that she had never absented from trial except on 19.01.2015.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in pursuance to the above order, petitioner has surrendered before the trial Court and has furnished the necessary bail bonds.

Accordingly, the interim bail furnished by the petitioner before the trial Court in pursuance to the order dated 14.05.2015, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
