Notice of motion to Advocate General, Punjab. Mr. K.S. Pannu, DAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3.

Petitioners, Jaswinder Kaur and Manpreet Singh, have moved this Court seeking protection on the ground that they have married on 11.05.2015 against the wishes of their parents and relatives.

Date of birth of petitioner – Manpreet Singh is 01.06.1992 as per Annexure P2 (original seen and returned). Regarding proof of date of birth of petitioner – Jaswinder Kaur, she submits in Court that her documents are lying in the house of her parents. She has given her date of birth as 05.12.1990 in her affidavit. She is surely not a minor as is clear from her appearance.

Counsel for the petitioners has stated that the petitioners had moved a representation (Annexure P-5) before the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, to seek protection, but no action has been taken by the police.

In this view of the matter, Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, is directed to look into the representation (Annexure P-5) and if there is any substance in it, may proceed further, in accordance with law.

The present order, however, shall not be deemed to be proof qua the factum/validity of any matrimonial alliance of the petitioners.
