After arguing the case for some time, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition. However, he refers to the inquiry report dated 10.09.2014 (Annexure P-3), and states that the allegations levelled against the mother-in-law and sister-in-law have been found to be incorrect. The inquiry could not proceed against the petitioner as he was away.

Dismissed as withdraw.

However, keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is a Jawan in the Indian Army, who has been devotedly performing his duty and the averment that he was not at home at the time of the alleged

occurrence, in case, the petitioner surrenders before the concerned Court within two weeks from today and prefers a bail application, the same be decided expeditiously, preferably within ten days from the date of filing such application.
