Petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.372 dated 20.11.2013, under Sections 323/324/148/149 IPC registered at Police Station 'A' Division, Amritsar City on the basis of compromise.

The said FIR was registered at the instance of respondent No.2 Shivam Prashar alleging that the petitioners along with 15-16 unidentified persons had constituted an unlawful assembly and attacked the complainant and his friend Satinder Pal Singh and gave them beatings and caused injuries.

Parties were directed to appear before the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Amritsar to get their statements recorded regarding the compromise. After recording the statements of the parties, a report has been

received to the effect that the matter has been compromised voluntarily and that there is no other party except for the petitioners, complainant and injured respondent No.3.

Following the Full Bench judgment of this Court in **Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and others, 2007 (3) R.C.R. (Criminal) 1052**, the petition is allowed. The aforesaid FIR and all the criminal proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise subject to petitioners depositing a total sum of Rs.10,000/- with Punjab State Legal Services Authority, Sector 22 Chandigarh and another total sum of Rs. 5,000/- with Punjab Police Welfare Fund, Sector 9, Chandigarh, within a period of one month.
