Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.374 dated 8.10.2012 under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 384, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Camp Palwal, District Palwal. In the aforesaid case, the petitioner has been summoned as an additional accused.

On May 18, 2015, this Court has passed the following order:

*“Present:- Mr. Keshav Pratap Singh, Advocate
for the petitioner.*

*Contends that the petitioner, who is not named in
the FIR has been summoned under Section 319 Cr.P.C. as an
additional accused despite the fact that it is the petitioner, who*

has put the criminal action in motion. He further submits that nothing is to be recovered from the petitioner and co-accused are already on bail.

Notice of motion for 6.8.2015.

In case the petitioner appears before the trial Court within one week from today, he shall be admitted to bail subject to furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to the aforesaid order, the petitioner has surrendered before the trial Court on 20.5.2015 and has been admitted on interim bail.

Considering the fact that the petitioner has surrendered before the trial Court and has been granted interim bail, the the present petition is allowed and the order dated 18.5.2015 passed by this Court is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall face the trial and shall appear before the trial Court as and when directed by the trial Court.
