Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.293 dated 25.11.2014, registered at Police Station Samana, District Patiala, under Sections 419, 420, 465, 468, 471, 212, 216, 120-B IPC read with Section 8 of the Punjab Good Conduct Release Act.

It is pertinent to mention here that petition qua petitioner Nos.1, 3, 5 and 6 has been dismissed vide order dated 19.05.2015 and petition qua petitioner No.2 has been dismissed as withdrawn vide order dated 09.07.2015.

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Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Vide order dated 19.05.2015, this Court directed that in the event of arrest, petitioner Nos.4 and 7 would be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer in connection with above-said case FIR.

On instructions from the investigating officer, learned State counsel informs that petitioner Nos.4 and 7 have joined the investigation. Learned State counsel further states that nothing is to be recovered from petitioner Nos.4 and 7 and their custodial interrogation is not required.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, order dated 19.05.2015 qua petitioner Nos.4 and 7 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Present petition is disposed of accordingly.
