1. The present petition has been filed by petitioners Angad Singh, Parminder Singh and Devinder Kaur, under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of the anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 56 dated 27.03.2015, under Sections 498-A, 406 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Zirakpur, District S.A.S.Nagar (Mohali).
2. Report of the Mediator received.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioners and learned counsel for the complainant stated that the matter has been amicably settled between the parties before the Mediator as per the settlement agreement dated 03.08.2015.

4. Mr. Vaneet Kumar Sharma, Advocate for the respondent-complainant has further stated that the complainant has already received Rs. 4 lacs before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court and remaining amount is to be paid in the proceedings for mutual divorce and quashing of the FIR. He has also stated that the jewelery articles have also been returned to the complainant before the Mediator.

5. In view of aforesaid, as the dowry articles have already been returned to the complainant, the matter has also been amicably settled between the parties and they are going to part their ways by way of divorce by mutual consent. So, the petitioners are not required for any custodial interrogation.

6. Learned State counsel on the instructions of ASI Narinder Kumar, Police Station Zirakpur has stated that all the petitioners have already joined the investigation and sufficiently interrogated.

7. So, the present petition is hereby allowed and the order of interim anticipatory bail dated 27.05.2015 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.
