The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking the concession of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.43 dated 28.03.2015, under Sections 420/467/468/471 IPC, registered at Police Station Morinda, District Rupnagar.

Counsel appearing for the petitioner having argued the matter at some length prays for withdrawal of the instant petition.

He, however, raises a submission that the petitioner is ready and willing to surrender before the trial Court and if a petition seeking benefit of regular bail is filed thereafter, he prays for issuance of directions for such application to be decided within a period of two days'.

As per prayer made by counsel for the petitioner, instant petition is dismissed as withdrawn.

It is, however, observed that in case the petitioner

surrenders before the trial Court within a period of one week from today and thereafter files an application seeking benefit of regular bail, the trial Court shall make every endeavor to expedite the hearing and disposal of the same.
