Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.48 dated 28.03.2015, under Sections 324, 323, 498-A, 427, 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 ('IPC' for short), registered at Police Station Dharamkot, District Moga.

While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed by this Court on 19.05.2015:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner relies upon CRMM-15232 of 2015 Swaran Singh Vs. State of Punjab fixed for 21.07.2015. Petitioner is brother-in-law of complainant. Teeth bite on the thumb of complainant besides causing damage to his car has been attributed to petitioner. Petitioner is willing to settle the dispute with his wife. Petitioner is having daughter from the wedlock.

Notice of motion 21.07.2015.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, petitioner shall

be admitted to interim bail, subject to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, petitioner shall abide by the conditions incorporated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel who is assisted by Head Constable Charanjit Singh has submitted that petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for further investigation. Learned State counsel has further submitted that offence under Section 325 IPC has been added later on.

Accordingly, interim bail granted to the petitioner by this Court vide order dated 19.05.2015, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
