Plaintiff-appellant has come up in regular second appeal against the judgment of dated 03.01.1991 passed by the Additional District Judge, Hoshiarpur, whereby his appeal against the judgment and decree dated 30.07.1990 passed by the Sub Judge, III Class, Hoshiarpur, had been accepted and his suit for declaration had been decreed to the effect that the impugned orders of termination dated 20.10.1978 and 20.04.1981 (communicated vide Endst. Dated 05.05.1981) were illegal, void and opposed to natural justice and the plaintiff was held entitled to rejoin his duty forthwith. However, he was not held entitled to any back wages for the period from 04.05.1978 till he joined the duty.

In the present appeal, the plaintiff-appellant is seeking grant of back wages along with other consequential benefits.

Vide judgment of even date passed in connected RSA No.991 of 1991 titled as The State of Punjab Vs. Amrit Singh, the suit filed by the plaintiff has been dismissed being time barred. Therefore, no ground is

made out to entertain the present appeal filed by the plaintiff-appellant against the judgment of the lower appellate Court, seeking relief of grant of back wages.

No substantial question of law arises for consideration.

Dismissed.
