JITENDRA CHAUHAN, J. (Oral)

The present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, 'the Cr.P.C.') seeking regular bail in case FIR No.58 dated 29.03.2014, registered under Sections 392, 382, 365, 201, 411, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 25 of the Arms Act, at Police Station City Rajpura, Distt. Patiala.

At the very outset, the learned State counsel, on instructions, informs that the petitioner is involved in four other FIRs. In case, he is released on bail, he is likely to influence and intimidate the complainant.

The learned counsel for the petitioner states that he is on bail in all those four FIRs.

Heard.

Keeping in view the antecedents of the petitioner, no case for grant of bail is made out.

Dismissed.

However, keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 14.04.2014, the trial Court is directed to conclude the trial expeditiously.
