Petitioners seeks pre-arrest bail in FIR No.146 dated 07.10.2014 under Sections 498-A, 406 IPC, registered at Police Station Majitha, District Amritsar Rural.

Notice of motion was issued and interim protection was granted.

It has gone undisputed between the parties that after conclusion of the investigation, cancellation report was prepared. However, on fresh complaint filed by the complainant, matter is again pending for consideration of the investigating agency.

Be that as it may, under these circumstances, petitioner has been found entitled for the concession of anticipatory bail. In this view of the matter, order dated 15.05.2015 passed by this Court is hereby made absolute, however, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
