Instant petition has been preferred under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 161 dated June 26, 2014 under Sections 323, 324, 326, 148 and 149 IPC registered at Police Station Patti, District Tarn Taran.

2. Undisputably, this is a version and cross-version case. Both the parties sustained injuries during the course of occurrence. It is yet to be established as to which of the parties was aggressor one. No doubt, an injury attributed to the present petitioner falls within the ambit of Section 326 IPC but Injured has since been discharged. Moreover, petitioner was arrested in this case on March 30, 2015 and was subjected to custodial interrogation and now he is in judicial custody. Meaning thereby, that he is not required for further interrogation. Investigation in this case is also almost complete and challan is likely to be presented in near future and disposal thereof, would take sufficient long time.

3. Taking into consideration all the above-said facts and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, instant petition is allowed and petitioner is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of learned trial Court.
