Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 14, dated 30.01.2015, under Sections 307, 34 IPC and 25 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Dhelon, Ludhiana.

Perusal of the FIR shows that there are specific allegations to the effect that petitioner was the person who had fired shot which hit on the person of the father of the complainant on his right thigh. There are specific allegations that the petitioner along with other co-accused have committed offence while the complainant and his father were on motor cycle. Custodial interrogation and recovery of weapon is necessary.

Keeping in view the gravity of offence, no ground for anticipatory bail is made out.

Dismissed.
