Petitioner seeks bail pending trial in FIR No.165 dated 10.03.2012 under Sections 148, 149, 307, 302, 395, 396, 357, 186, 332, 353, 120-B IPC and Sections 25, 54, 59 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Jhajjar, District Jhajjar.

After arguing the case for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission of the Court to withdraw the present petition, however with a prayer that the learned trial Court may be directed to expedite the trial and conclude the same within a specified period, keeping in view the custody period of the petitioner which is about three years and five months.

Permission is granted.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

However, the learned trial Court is directed to make sincere efforts to expedite the trial and conclude the same at an early date because

the petitioner is inside the jail for the last about three years and five months, besides the fact that petitioner is an old lady of about 72 years. Endeavour shall be made by the learned trial Court to conclude the trial as early as possible.

Disposed of, accordingly.
