RAJ MOHAN SINGH, J. (Oral)

Petitioner seeks regular bail in case bearing FIR No.57 dated 16.02.2015 under Section 386, 389, 328, 506, 34 IPC, Police Station, Rania, District Sirsa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that offences are triable by Magistrate. It is only with the aid of Section 328 IPC, complicity of the petitioner was alleged in respect of administering poisonous substance to the complainant. Learned counsel for the complainant as well as State counsel on instructions from SI Amar Nath states that complainant has not been medically examined. Learned counsel for the complainant states that now the case is

fixed for framing of charge on 16.07.2015. Mr. Yashwinder, DAG, Haryana states that co-accused are still at large and PO proceedings have been initiated against Harpinder Singh and Simranjit. Factum of filing challan has been admitted. Apparently, the accusation in terms of Section 328 IPC would remain a debatable issue in the absence of any medical examination and incriminating material collected by the police in order to attract such culpability. Petitioner is in custody since 28.02.2015. Co-accused namely Jasvir Kaur has since been granted regular bail by this Court in CRM-M-14614 of 2015. Petitioner is an aged lady of more than 70 years of age.

At this stage, without embarking upon merits of this case, let the petitioner be enlarged on regular bail, subject to her furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of CJM, Sirsa.

Nothing expressed hereinabove would be construed to be an opinion on merits.
