MAHESH GROVER, J.

The petitioner prays for grant of interim bail in case FIR no. 1201 dated 7.10.2011 registered under Sections 302, 34, 120-B, 216, 365 IPC and Sections 25, 54 of Arms Act at Police Station City Panipat.

It is the stated case of the petitioner that his wife is ailing on account of kidney failure requiring dialysis. In view of her poor health, his children need to be taken care of. He prays that if three weeks interim bail is granted to the petitioner he would be able to make alternate arrangements for the custody of his children and some arrangements for the welfare of his wife.

Learned counsel for the respondents on instructions from SI Ramesh Kumar states that they have verified the fact of ailment of petitioner's wife but the medical certificate is from a private hospital.

Be that as it may, since there is no material to suggest that the contention of the learned counsel for the petitioner is wrong, instant petition is accepted. It is directed that the petitioner be released on interim bail for a

period of three weeks commencing from 3.6.2015 to 24.6.2015, subject to the satisfaction of the learned Trial Court/Duty Magistrate. Petitioner shall be required to surrender on 25.6.2015 before the Jail authorities/ Trial Court.
